

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
CITY OF ELWOOD, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA
COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MUNICIPAL BUILDING
JULY 08, 2024 6:30PM**

Meeting called to order by Council President, John Wright followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer. Members present: Dave Abernathy, Kim Everson, Joe Kelich, Danielle Noone, Sam Tyner, Jim Watters and John Wright. City Attorney, Jeff Graham was present for the meeting.

Chuck Bronnenberg, 200 North 3rd St, requested the council consider making North 3rd and North C Streets truck routes to better help serve his business.

Minutes from the June 03, 2024 regular meeting were presented to the council for approval. Abernathy made a motion to approve; seconded by Noone. All in favor.

Watters made a motion to suspend the meeting and open the public hearing regarding ELSA compliance statements; seconded by Kelich. All in favor.

There was no public comment.

Watters made a motion to close public hearing and reconvene the meeting; seconded by Kelich. All in favor.

Abernathy made a motion to read and consider Ordinance 2465; seconded by Kelich. All in favor. Ordinance 2465 read title only. Noone made a motion for unanimous passage on the same night as introduced; seconded by Kelich. All in favor. Kelich made a motion to vote on Ordinance 2465 by roll call vote; seconded by Abernathy. Roll call: Abernathy - aye, Everson - aye, Kelich - aye, Noone - aye, Tyner - aye, Watters - aye, Wright - aye. Ordinance 2465 passed.

Everson requested the council look at the railroad crossing at South C and 24th Streets. It is the only crossing without flashers or arms. There are bushes blocking the view to cross safely. Cutting the bushes back would be a good short-term fix but need to reach out to the railroad to try to get a more permanent fix.


Tyner made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Noone. All in favor.
