Everson requested the council look at the railroad crossing at South C and 24<sup>th</sup> Streets. It is the only crossing without flashers or arms. There are bushes blocking the view to cross safely. Cutting the bushes back would be a good short-term fix but need to reach out to the railroad to try to get a more permanent fix.
