Watters made a motion to vote on Resolution 2024-10 by roll call vote; seconded by Kelich. Roll call: Abernathy - aye, Everson – aye, Kelich – aye, Noone – aye, Watters – aye, Wright - aye. Resolution 2024-10 passed.
