

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Meeting called to order by Mayor Todd Jones. Members present: Kelli Boyland, Mark Crim, Sam Tyner and Jim Watters. City Attorney, Jeff Graham was present for the meeting.

Minutes for the October 06, 2025 regular meeting were presented to the board for approval. Crim made a motion to approve; seconded by Watters. All in favor.

Claims for the city and utilities were presented to the board for approval. The October claims totaled \$1,607,895.32. Watters made a motion to approve the claims; seconded by Boyland. All in favor.

Utility adjustments were presented to the board for approval. Water adjustments totaled \$-250.86, Wastewater totaled \$-3,955.53, and Trash totaled \$-55.41 for a grand total of \$-4,261.80. Watters made a motion to accept the adjustments; seconded by Crim. All in favor.

Captain Marcus Shoppell presented a claim for Flock safety cameras in the amount of \$7,650.00 to the board for approval. Boyland made a motion to approve; seconded by Watters. All in favor.

An agreement between Republic Services and the City of Elwood Animal Shelter for waste disposal was presented to the board for approval. Crim made a motion to approve; seconded by Watters. All in favor.

An agreement between Republic Services and the City of Elwood Municipal Building for waste disposal was presented to the board for approval. Watters made a motion to approve; seconded by Tyner. All in favor.

An addendum for O’Neal Golf Management, LLC to manage the golf course for the 2026 season was presented to the board for approval. Boyland made a motion to approve; seconded by Crim. All in favor.

An agreement between Barnes & Thornburg and the City of Elwood for bond counsel services was presented to the board for approval. Boyland made a motion to approve; seconded by Crim. All in favor.

Watters made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Boyland. All in favor.
